<u>Highway</u>

Mr. Yungfleisch reported:

- The crew has been plowing and salting when needed.

Yungfleisch shared that it has been very muddy and he is still hoping to get out there and add some for the town in a few locations.

ZEO/CEO

Mr. Mikolajczyk's report was emailed to the members of the Town Board and is also available in the Town Clerk's office.

Town Clerk

Town Clerk Werth reported that she took in \$979.76 and remitted \$933.76 to the Supervisor for local share, \$31.00 to NYS Ag. & Markets for spay/neuter program. We also had a total of 67 conservation customers.

We continue to collect the Water Service Applications for the Town of Batavia. A total of 8 residents applied in November.

<u>Supervisor</u>

Supervisor Hynes reported:

- Phase 1 of WD2 is installed and fully in service. Restoration is complete, a few areas will need to be addressed in the Spring.
- Phase 2 of WD2 is well under way and proceeding nicely. Randsco will be working two days the week of the 24th and 3 days the week of the 31st. They should be near completion by mid January.
- We are waiting on the bonds and insurance documents to arrive for Phase 3, WD2. Once it is here we will sign and pass onto Rural Development for approval. Sergi expects to start mid January.
- Copies of the bills and engineer reports are available to review for the bank property. Discussion ensued. Councilwoman Marshall would like Supervisor Hynes to contact Ned Dale, school Superintendent to discuss the options of renting space at the school.
- We continue to answer questions from the State auditor.
- The County did a Safe Act resolution, they will not support new legislation regarding this.
- Councilwoman Marshall asked that Supervisor Hynes contact the insurance company to get a cost on Cyber and EEOC insurance. Also question what would be included in the Cyber insurance.

Councilpersons/Miscellaneous

Councilman Chamberlain stated he attended the School Board meeting Monday evening. The new Superintendent, Ned Dale introduced himself and Mr. Chamberlain felt he had some good ideas. Mr. Dale asked him to continue helping with the Budget Ambassador's committee.
