- The remaining land in 9.-1-42.121 will be merged with 9.-1-42.11 to prevent a land-locked parcel
- C. Hoover will check with county planning on the mylar survey maps, which were dated in December 2021 and if he can update and sign mylar to 2022. If so, they can proceed.
